total program period 6-8 weeks

## course details

duration approx. 2-3 weeks  
location at home institute  
methods self-study and group projects  
tools Internet and social media  
suggestion connect students and local buddies online prior to Journey

## 1. knowledge

study factors that influence people and society

### assignment

students select their destination(s) and identify the perceptions they have about the people and society

### expected output

students document their perceptions in the Before Video and send the video to the host institute prior to journey

### assignment

students study the social, political and historical factors that influence people and society

### expected output

students formulate key questions about people and society that they will research during the journey

## course details

duration minimum 3 days per country  
location at host institute  
methods Journey and Beyond Perceptions  
tools activities and interaction with locals  
suggestion local buddies make a Before VDO with perceptions about visiting students

## 2. experience

travel to experience people and society

### assignment

students travel to the country to experience people and society themselves

### expected output

students and local buddies discuss mutual perceptions in Beyond Perceptions

### assignment

students travel to the country and do research to find answers to their key questions

### expected output

students conduct interviews and collect data that will substantiate the answers to their key questions

## course details

duration approx. 3-4 weeks  
location at home institute  
methods self-reflection  
tools collected research materials  
suggestion final phase allows for formal assessment and grades or credits

## 3. understanding

reflection on views about people and society

### assignment

students reflect on perceptions and personal experience to identify their views on people and society

### expected output

students document their views in the After Video as part of their final assessment

### assignment

students answer their key questions using their research and personal experiences

### expected output

students do a final presentation to demonstrate their knowledge and understanding of people and society
